

APHS STUDENT DRESS CODE

Students must follow the Dress Code from the time they arrive on campus until they leave campus.

- I. Shoes shall be worn at all times. Heelies, roller shoes, bedroom slippers, etc. are not allowed.
- II. Dresses, skirts, shorts and skorts shall be below mid-thigh with no slits above mid-thigh.
- III. Formfitting, body hugging clothes including leggings are not allowed.
- IV. Pants must be zipped, worn at the natural waistline, and be no longer in length than the heels of the shoes.
- V. No head coverings or hats are allowed.
- VI. Blouses, shirts, and dresses shall not:
 1. Be Strapless
 2. Be Transparent
 3. Reveal Bare Midriff
 4. Be Low Cut
- VII. Undergarments must be worn but not visible.
- VIII. All clothing must be worn right side out.
- IX. Students may not wear clothing or display jewelry, buttons or any other items (including tattoos) with words, phrases, symbols, pictures, patches or graphics which are indecent, hazardous, offensive or sexually suggestive.
- X. Choke or wallet chains and chain belts are not allowed.

School administrators have the final authority to determine when personal appearance and dress do not meet Board and school standards and have the authority to take appropriate action.
